CFF is the parent support group for Community Magnet Charter School. We're a non-profit organization, led by elected parent volunteers, that organizes school activities and supplements the funding gap between what LAUSD provides for our school and what our school and students need. For CFF to be effective, everyone's participation is essential. Whether it is attending CFF member meetings, supporting a fundraising event, or working on one of our committees, please participate because we can't do any of this without you.

Last school year, we didn't know what to expect. Many hoped it would be a return to normal, but we quickly realized that due to Covid-19, there was no going back to the way things were. It was a year of uncertainty, change, and adaptation – but also of tremendous success. Students returned to the classroom, we resumed a lot of CMCS traditions like Parade of Masks and Sweethearts Dance on campus, albeit a little differently, and had another successful year of fundraising. We met our fundraising goal of \$340,000 to fully fund ALL our enrichment programs for this school year – art, physical education, technology, dance, drama/improv, chess, and more! And, with the funds we didn't use last year from money set aside for field trips and CATCH, we purchased a \$12,000 professional grade projector and lens for the auditorium to replace the one that was over 20 years old. We will also be working with Principal Toni to help purchase some security equipment for our campus. You did all this Community!

Let's keep it going! Inflation has affected everyone and almost everything has increased in price, including some of the programs we fund. Although we don't need to increase our budget for next school year, it's important to meet our fundraising goal of \$340,000. While it may seem daunting, we can do this by working TOGETHER. More than ever, we need 100% participation with ALL our fundraising so we shoulder this responsibility together and ensure we keep the wonderful programs that make CMCS so special. Our kids are worth it!

We truly believe that with **<u>strong</u>** volunteer efforts, fundraising support, and dedication from you, the parents and families of students attending Community Magnet Charter School, we can continue to make CMCS stronger and better!
